

Erasmus+: A strong international dimension


- Collaboration with Partner Countries: mobility, cooperation and policy dialogue activities.
- In order to support European organisations in facing the global challenges brought about by globalisation, climate change and the digital transition, a key element is the intensification of international mobility and cooperation with third countries, strengthening the role of the European Union as a global actor.
- In parallel, the Programme actions contribute to promoting values, principles and interests around common priorities, notably related to human and institutional development climate change, digital transition, growth and jobs, good governance and peace and security.
- The engagement of the young people in Partner Countries is a key element in the process of building societies that are more resilient and are based on mutual trust and intercultural understanding.

Erasmus+: internationalisation mechanism

- "Internationalisation of higher education: the synergy of the activities at the global, regional, national and institutional levels to ensure and improve the quality of higher education.
- Strategy of the internationalisation of higher education: vector of the development that identifies mission (aim), vision, values, directions, urgent priorities and indicators of higher education development in the context of the objectives of global dimension of higher education.
- Mechanism of internationalisation based on the implementation of the EU international cooperation programmes: a system of institutions and procedures, processes and activities that have managerial impact on the development of higher education in the context of internationalisation by means of consistent organisation and regulation of the implementation of the EU international cooperation programmes and mutual programmed exploitation of best practices of international experience based on interinstitutional collaboration".




Digital ERASMUS+





Erasmus Mundus Joint Masters (EMJM)

- Excellent integrated Master courses offered by consortia of 3+ full partner HEIs from three different countries, of which at least two must be EU Member States or Associated third countries
- Attract best students worldwide through EU-funded scholarships
- Duration: 6 academic years covering at least 4 editions of the master programme
- 1 to 2 academic years (60, 90 or 120 ECTS credits) with study in 2+ countries, of which at least one must be an EU MS or Associated third country
- Institutions from all over the world may submit a proposal on behalf of an international consortium





International credit mobility



- Short-term studies or traineeships abroad (2-12 months) that count to a degree back home
- At bachelor, master and doctoral level...
- ...and for staff (5 days 2 months)
- Grants to cover travel and living costs
- HEIs from EU MS and associated third countries may apply to their National Agency

Capacity building for higher education

2022 call



Ukraine within EU Programme Erasmus+ 2014-2020

In the context of Erasmus+ Calls 2014-2020, all in all 245 (out of 281) UA HEIs as well as over 3 000 NGOs, national and regional authorities, research institutions, enterprises have been cooperating with partners from the EU Member States and other countries in the world and achieved the following results in statistics:
