The deadline for submission is April 1, 2021.

## FORMATTING REQUIREMENTS

Only papers related to the scope of the Conference are accepted. File types: Word or RTF.

The file's title should include an author's name (Ivanenko\_paper.doc or Ivanenko\_application.doc).

Page limits: max 6 pages (including references).

Your paper file must adhere to the following formatting requirements: do not number the pages or include line numbering;

the main text must be in single-column format, 1,5 spaced, in Times New Roman 14 font, paragraph -1,25; the manuscript must be alignment justified; nothing should be underlined; there should be no endnotes.

A paper should use in-text citation. A direct quotation should include the number of a source in the list of references and the page number, for example [2, p. 65].

The list of references should be provided after the main body of text (rubric 'References'). The list of references should be indexed (1, 2, 3...) and use OSCOLA style or State Standard of Ukraine 8302:2015 'Information and documentation. Bibliographic references. General provisions and rules of drafting' for the bibliographies

Works that do not meet the requirements or sent after the expiration of the prescribed period are not considered.
