# What is international mobility?

- International opening of Erasmus
- 135,000 grants in 6 years
- For students & staff (for learning & teaching)
- Action managed by National Agencies located in programme countries



## Types and duration

- All levels (short cycle, Bachelor, Master, PhD)
- All disciplines
- 3 to 12 months for studies
- Up to 12 months per study cycle
- For staff – from 5 days to 2 months

- **Inter-institutional agreements** to set mobility flows & preconditions - signed before mobilities start

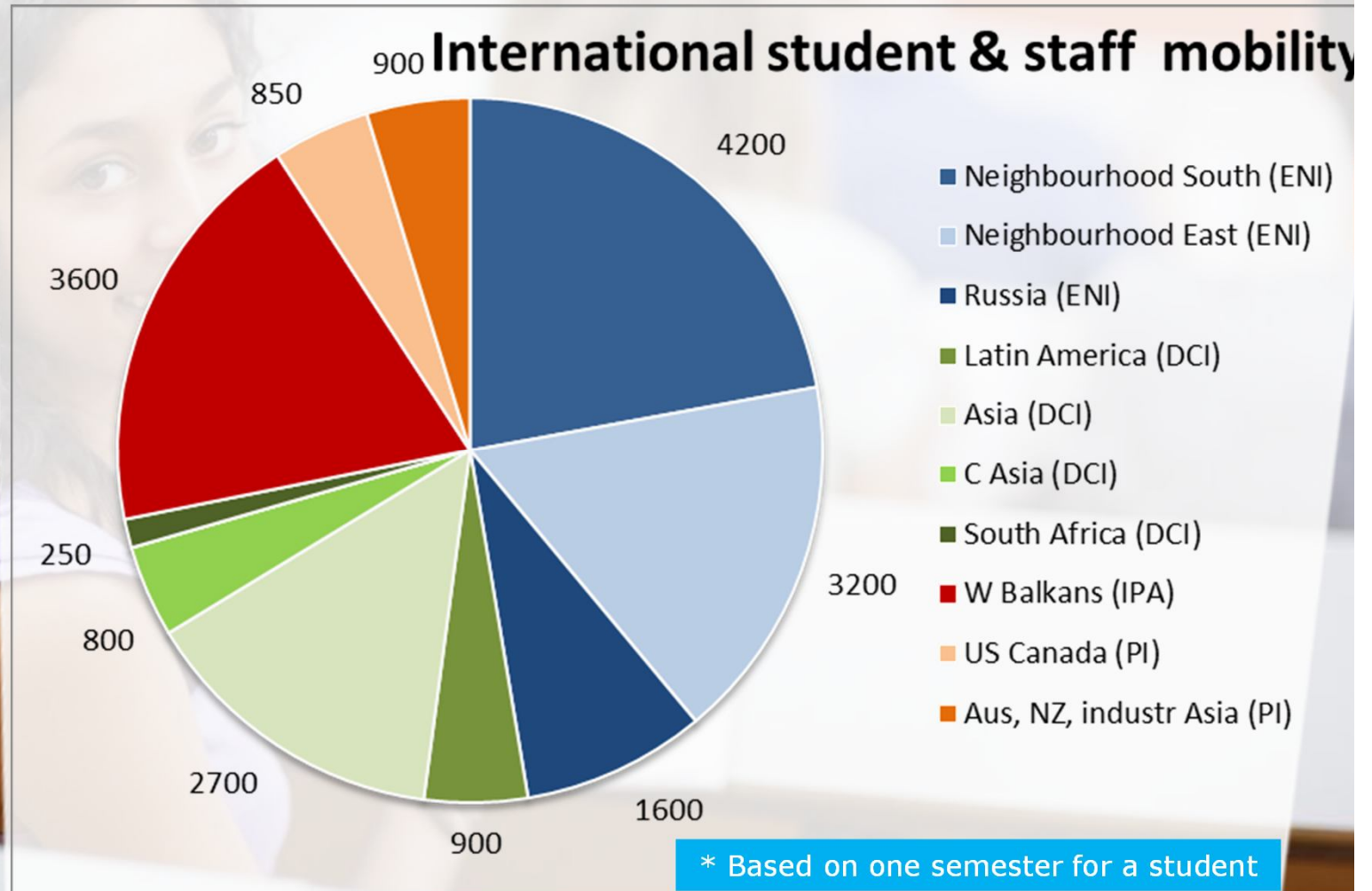
