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

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
Higher Education Institutions (2014-2015)





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
Number of Students

Curricula development:

- Establishment of an interdisciplinary Master in European Cultural Anthropology;
- Development of modules on migration and social inclusion for an existing Master in Law;
- Implementation of a Master Program in Human Rights;
- Development of modules in Geodesy, Cadaster and Geotechnics (Bachelor and Master);
- Professionalization of the Master in Applied Languages and Tourism / International Trade.



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KA 2. Capacity building in Higher Education – project proposals

Improving quality in education:

- Connecting/ Alignment of research and industry in the food industry;
- Update of the research methodology in the food industry;
- Implementation of teaching and learning methods in the field of medical education;
- Creation of a doctoral college in social sciences;
- Setting up a double degree program (Bachelor) in Applied Languages/ Management / Geodesy;
- Developing mechanisms in quality assurance, evaluation and program accreditation - support for a good functionality of the National Agency for Quality Assurance in Education (in force since April 2015).



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KA 2. Capacity building in Higher Education – project proposals

Improving management and operation of HEIs :

- **Institutional capacity building:**
 - ✓ Support for the new university management structure (dual management);
 - ✓ Support for the functioning of the administrative departments (HR, Finance and Financial Planning);
- **Development of the recently established doctoral schools' capacity (43 schools approved in October 2015);**
- **Development of internationalization strategies (including the recognition of qualifications and mobility management).**
