

40% - new partners (Germany, Italy, Poland, Cyprus)


Structures in place to support academic mobility



Search for new opportunities on academic mobility

- Communication with partners and coordinating offices/points;
- > Development of the University profile;
- Translation and verification of the application docs;
- > Description of courses offered;
- > Transfer of credits;
- Dissemination
- > Reporting
- > Statistical analysis

Erasmus+ application process



Synergy of academic and administrative staff work: ✓ academic – categories, quotas, mobility content ✓ administrative – documentation, recognition, deadlines

Clear agreements of partners before launching mobility: ✓ on matching schedules ✓ on lists of courses/modules offered and recognition procedures
