

Grant Reductions

Article 28 of your Grant Agreement:

- The granting authority may reduce the grant for a beneficiary, if the beneficiary has committed serious breach of obligations under this Agreement or during its award (including improper implementation of the action, non-compliance with the call conditions, submission of false information, failure to provide required information, breach of ethics or security rules (if applicable), etc.),
