



Ukraine is under attack

A new reality for the certificate of birth for a kid from Ukraine, if her parents are killed or this small Ukrainian girl died, kidnaped or get lost....

• 382 children are killed and more than 740 are injured

This data does not include information from areas where the active hostilities take place.

- 5401 civilians are killed, plus over 87 000 in Mariupol (tbc)
- 7466 civilians are injured
- Over 2 mln. Ukrainians were forced to go to <u>russia</u>
- 3 mln. people: in the territories under invasion
- <u>11.98 million people displaced</u> due to the war against Ukraine, over 6,8 mln. abroad; 5,3 mln. returned back
- out of 10.5 mln. young people: 2 mln. are internally displaced and 2 mln. are abroad!
- 2461 education institutions have suffered bombing and shelling
- 286 educational institutions have been destroyed completely




Universities relocated... Students recruited and started education...

- Where necessary, educational institutions were relocated to the territory controlled by Ukraine's Authorities and continue educational process during war in online/blended formats based on the situation and possibility to ensure shelters and other safety measures.
- 30 higher education institutions, 65 HEI affiliated units and 44 professional pre-higher educational institutions were displaced.
- Professional pre-higher and higher education institutions applications up to 1,14 millions: 636,000 for Bachelor and medical Master programs, 202,5000 for Master programs,
- 205,600 for professional bachelor programs, 1,700 for junior bachelor programs.

Largest number of applications submitted to the professional pre-higher and higher education institutions in Kyiv, Lviv, Dnipropetrovsk, and Kharkiv



Stop recognition of russian diplomas, they are not in Bologna Process any more!

Ukrainians are not refugees – not refused by our country... but temporary relocated/under protection.








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


RUSSIA DESTROYS UKRAINE'S EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS



EVEN WAR HAS RULES

Many decades ago, the international community decided to stop large-scale deaths of civilians during wars and armed conflicts. Thus the rules of war were created, which forbade the killing of civilians, the infliction of harm and torture on prisoners, and the launching of lethal weapons into unprotected settlements.

Despite the fact that the rules of war are set out in international treaties such as the Geneva Conventions, the Rome Statute, and other international laws and agreements, many of which Russia is a signatory to.

RUSSIA'S WAR ON UKRAINE: UKRAINIAN STUDENTS IN THE EU



Russia's invasion of Ukraine on 24 February 2022 has caused vast displacement of people within the country as well as across the EU borders. While the annexation of Crimea had a negative impact on the country's education system, recent events have added additional strain.

Outbound student mobility was already substantial in recent years, but it has accelerated even further since the Crimean conflict began. After doubling from some 25 000 to nearly 50 000 between 2007 and 2014, the number of Ukrainian students abroad has since skyrocketed by another 54 % to around 78 000 in 2019.

Approximately 49 000 Ukrainian students were attending various higher education institutions across the EU in 2019. This means that approximately 60 % of the 78 000 Ukrainians studying abroad worldwide in 2019 chose to study in the EU. The countries welcoming the highest numbers of students are Poland, Germany, Czechia and Slovakia.

Some 480 Ukrainian students are currently engaged in Erasmus+ activities via the programme's international strand. In the 2015-2019 programming period, Ukraine received 40 % of the available funding in the Eastern Partnership region, and over 9 000 Ukrainian students and staff participated in more than 1 300 Erasmus projects.

Following the Russian invasion of Ukraine, Commissioner Mariya Gabriel announced, on 2 March 2022, that the Commission would grant maximum flexibility in the implementation of Erasmus+ projects involving Ukrainian

higher education students and staff, National Erasmus agencies can apply the force majeure clause for international mobility activities taking place in Ukraine and Russia. This will allow beneficiaries to cancel, postpone or rearrange planned activities in the most flexible way possible.

In addition, the Commission has invited Erasmus national agencies and participating organisations to contact beneficiaries who are currently located in Ukraine or Russia






Challenges for cooperation under Mobility Projects

- To find contact information of the HEIs to discuss support needed
- Force Majeure Circumstances: suspend or continue with redesigning
- Staff safety, activities delays, changes, damages, new workplan/activitie
- Payments delay, state treasury and banks issues etc. However changes to Regulation adopted already to allow payments under the projects – <u>New Regulation at the link</u>
- To receive the permission from the management for staff, researchers and students mobility
- For management staff and for man to receive permission from the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine to cross the border

To apply flexibility within Ukrainian HEIs:

- update for the Internal Regulations on the International Cooperation/Mobility is required
- Nomination vs selection procedures update, if needed
- Signatures of Interinstitutional Agreements is a must for recognition



Challenges for Mobility Projects

- Institutional regulation for Mobility does not reflect the war time!
- Not ready/able to apply flexibility
- Recognition by the EU universities of prior study or belonging to the university without the documents which were lost/destroyed during war/ recognition for mobility periods
- Study or Traineeship for 1st year students, longer period of semester 4th year students
- Teaching, Training, Job shadowing for staff
- Passport, visa and crossing the border
- Temporary protection status vs students visa etc.







Crossing the border as of 8.09.22*

The male students and staff 18-60 years old

are **not allowed to cross the border** with some exceptions!!!


- University students have the right for the postpone of the mobilization for study period!!!
- However it does not provide automatic permission for the border crossing!!!
- At the same time the final decision is taken by the Border Control Officer based on the provided documents.

The documents package:

- Enrolment/Admission/ Acceptance for Students; Invitation letter for staff (original is advisable)
- Students visa or Students Card (if applicable)
- Certificate from the Military Service Center of Ukraine is obligatory document in the package of documents for the crossing the border
- Additionally, if applicable: Mobility Agreement, Inter-Institutional Agreements, Nomination letter, Health Insurance Certificate, Letter form home university and MESU etc.

Crossing border by <u>male students and staff</u> during Martial Law is regulated by the Decree of the President of Ukraine of 24.02.2022 No 64/2022 «On the imposition of martial law in Ukraine». The Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine Regulation No 264 dated as of 12/03/2022 (https://zakon.rada.gov.ua/laws/show/264-2022-%D0%BF#Text) regulated exceptions which include among other things: "... students for studying abroad in full-time or dual forms of education; people with disabilities and accompanying persons..." Needs: Erasmus+ Programme level

- High need to respond the war and crises challenges and their consequences: create the Urgency Envelope. Relocation of funds remained from other regions on the decentralised actions into this envelope to respond support e.g. Ukraine optimisation and more effective usage of unspent funds.
- Erasmus 'zero' grant for mobility could be a practical mechanism to enrol the students into the courses at the EU universities with the temporary protection status funding (if available).
- To increase the budget for the Erasmus+ Actions by opening the Special Window for Ukraine (Moldova, Georgia) and all Actions for overall capacity building for countries under transformation into and smooth integration to the potential status of the 3rd Country Associated to the Programme based on the similar approach done for the Western Balkans Countries for 2021-2027.
