

Strenghtening the education digital environment for Ukraine


- Part of the Erasmus+ CBHE new Call, under Strand 3

- The EU grant will be EUR 5 000 000 for only one project

Erasmus+ Virtual Exchanges in higher education and youth

- Call 2021:
 - 13 selected projects in total
 - Ukrainian institutions are full partners in 7 projects and associated partners in 3 projects
- Call 2022: 13 Ukrainian instances of participation in submitted proposals, evaluation process is ongoing
