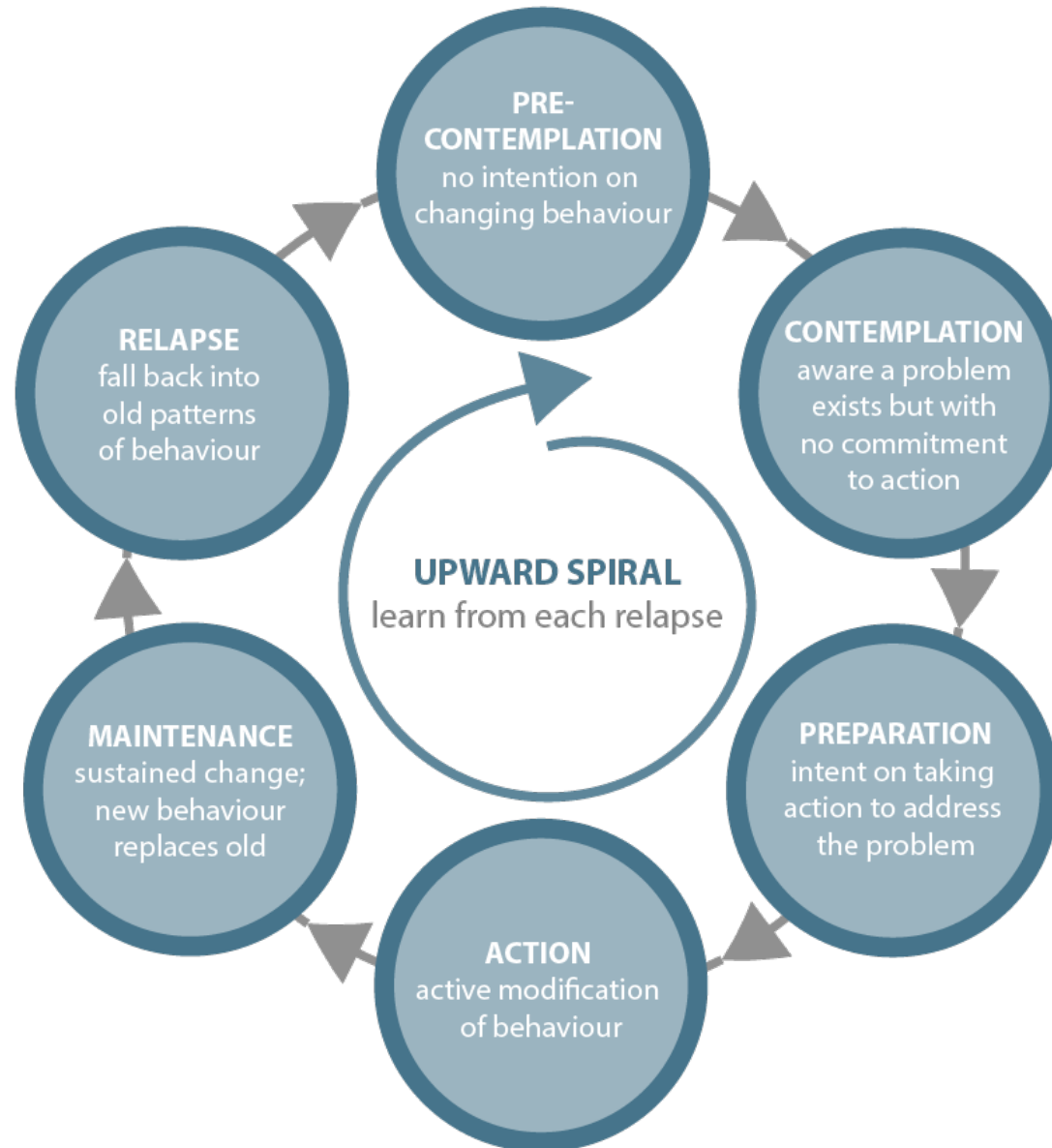


Communication strategies

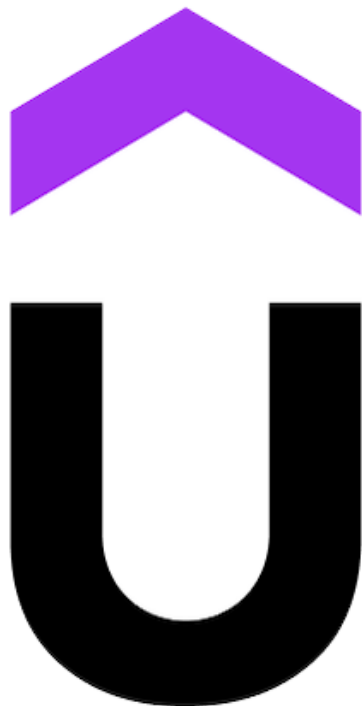
