Information on the CBHE projects data is provided based on the recommended for funding projects as of October 2023. Further updates will be provided after the Grant Agreements signatures.

The presented analysis of the data on the number of Erasmus+ CBHE projects implemented by Ukrainian HEIs during 2021-2023 gives grounds for such conclusions.

89 HEIs from 21 (out of 25) regions of Ukraine and Kyiv are involved in the partnerships of 33 CBHE projects. So, 26 % of the total number of Ukrainian HEIs participated in funded CBHE projects in 2021-2023.

Among these HEIs there are 10 Universities from the Donetsk, Luhansk, Zaporizhzhya and Kherson regions – front-line zones, which were displaced to other regions or cities. In general, there are 93 completely destroyed and/or damaged HEIs (27 % of the total number of HEIs) and 19 displaced HEIs (5.5 %) in Ukraine.

Ternopil (56 %) and Chernihiv (50 %) regions are the *leaders* in the coverage of HEIs.

The *leading regions* in terms of the number of CBHE projects are LVIV (20), KHARKIV (16), DNIPRO (15) regions and KYIV city (23).

The *leading HEIs* in terms of the number of CBHE projects are Universities that are top-ranking and well experienced in the implementation of international projects – IVAN FRANKO NATIONAL UNIVERSITY OF LVIV (6), LVIV POLITECHNIC NATIONAL UNIVERSITY (6), KYIV TARAS SHEVCHENKO NATIONAL UNIVERSITY (4), V.N. KARAZIN KHARKIV NATIONAL UNIVERSITY (4), located in large cities of Ukraine, as well as HEIs with limited experience – CHERNIHIV POLYTECHNIC NATIONAL UNIVERSITY (6), DNIPRO UNIVERSITY OF TECHNOLOGY (5), BOGDAN KHMELNITSKY MELITOPOL STATE PEDAGOGICAL UNIVERSITY (displaced from temporary occupied territory to Zaporizhzhya) (4). It is important to focus work on relocated and novices from regions of Ukraine.



Представлений аналіз даних щодо кількості проєктів з розвитку потенціалу вищої освіти – CBHE Програми Еразмус+, що реалізуються українськими закладами вищої освіти протягом 2022-2023 рр., дає підстави для таких висновків.

До партнерств 33 проєктів залучені 89 ЗВО з 21 (із 26) області України та м. Києва. Отже, 26 % від загальної кількості українських ЗВО брали участь в проєктах у 2022-2023 рр.

Серед цих закладів є 10 ЗВО з Донецької, Луганської, Запорізької та Херсонської області – прифронтових зон бойових дій, що були переміщені в інші регіони або міста. Загалом, в Україні 93 повністю зруйнованих та/або пошкоджених ЗВО (27 %) та 19 переміщених (5,5 %).

Лідерами за охопленням закладів є Тернопільська (56 %) та Чернігівська (50 %) області.

Регіони-лідери за кількістю проєктів є Київ (23), Львів (20), Харків (16), Дніпро (15).

Зкладами-лідерами за кількістю проєктів є як повідні та досвідчені в реалізації міжнародних проєктів ЗВО – IVAN FRANKO NATIONAL UNIVERSITY OF L'VIV (6), LVIV POLITECHNIC NATIONAL UNIVERSITY (6), KYIV TARAS SHEVCHENKO NATIONAL UNIVERSITY (4), V.N. KARAZIN KHARKIV NATIONAL UNIVERSITY (4), що розташовані у великих містах України так і ЗВО з обмеженим досвідом – CHERNIHIV POLYTECHNIC NATIONAL UNIVERSITY (6), DNIPRO UNIVERSITY OF TECHNOLOGY (5), BOGDAN KHMELNITSKY MELITOPOL STATE PEDAGOGICAL UNIVERSITY (*переміщений до Запоріжжя*) (4).

Важливо посилити роботу з регіонами і максимально залучити переміщені та заклади новачки.
