The Maastricht University (UM) is the most international university in the Netherlands and stands out for its innovative education model, international character and multidisciplinary approach to research and education. Today UM is considered one of the best young universities in the world.

He is results-driven senior policy advisor. Passionate about global higher education policy as a means to create better societies. Since 2017 he strategically advises the UM Executive Board and oversee the implementation of UM's internationalisation policy. Expert's areas of expertise include advisory functions regarding the internationalisation of higher education (for different management levels), with particular attention for developing and implementing university internationalisation strategies, quality assurance, international student mobility policy and research on EU affairs:

- Developing and overseeing the implementation of the internationalisation policy of the university
- Advising the Executive Board and the faculties with regards to strategic issues in internationalisation policy, such as the participation in strategic university networks, language policy, Erasmus+ (all project lines), scholarships and the European Universities Initiative (EUI)
- Representing Maastricht University nationally and internationally at conferences and during delegation visits
- Advising the UM President as the chair of the Strategic Board for Internationalisation (SBI), which sets the university-wide strategy for internationalisation
- Developing the UM's COVID-19 response, as the sole internationalisation representative in the UM Crisis Management Team (CMT) led by the Executive Board.
