The presented analysis of the data on the number of Erasmus+ CBHE projects implemented by Ukrainian HEIs during 2021-2025 gives grounds for such conclusions.

121 HEIs from 24 regions of Ukraine and Kyiv city are involved in the implementation of 69 CBHE projects. So, as for 2025 39 % of the total number of Ukrainian HEIs participated in CBHE projects in 2021-2025 (7 % growth in 2025).

Among these HEIs there are 17 Universities from the Donetsk (7), Luhansk (2), Zaporizhzhya (6) and Kherson (2) regions – occupied territories / front-line combat zones, which were displaced to other, safer regions or cities. In general, there are 93 completely destroyed and/or damaged HEIs (36 % of the total number of HEIs (314) and 19 displaced HEIs (6 %) in Ukraine.

In 2025, **20 newcomers** (first time in CBHE project within 2021-2025: 2 research institutions and 18 HEIs, incl. 3 relocated HEIs and 1 as a Coordinator-Grantholder) from different regions of Ukraine joined the cohort of Universities participating in CBHE projects (Kuras Institute of Politics and Ethnic Studies (1) and Institute for Single Crystals (1) of the National Academy of Sciences of Ukraine; VASYL STEFANYK CARPATHIAN NATIONAL UNIVERSITY (2), NATIONAL UNIVERSITY "ODESSA MARITIME ACADEMY" (2), BORYS GRINCHENKO KYIV METROPOLITAN UNIVERSITY (1), KROK UNIVERSITY (1), LVIV UNIVERSITY OF TRADE AND ECONOMICS (1), DNIPRO STATE AGRARIAN AND ECONOMIC UNIVERSITY (1), ODESA I.I. MECHNIKOV NATIONAL UNIVERSITY (1), ZAPORIZHZHYA INSTITUTE OF ECONOMICS AND INFORMATION TECHNOLOGIES (1), PENITENTIARY ACADEMY OF UKRAINE (1), KAMIANETS-PODILSKYI IVAN OHIIENKO NATIONAL UNIVERSITY (1), VINNYTSIA NATIONAL AGRARIAN UNIVERSITY (1), NATIONAL UNIVERSITY OF OSTROH ACADEMY (1) HRYHORII SKOVORODA UNIVERSITY IN PEREIASLAV (1), STATE TAX UNIVERSITY (1), PRYAZOVSKYI STATE TECHNICAL UNIVERSITY (Mariupol, relocated, **Dnipro**) (1), DMYTRO MOTORNYI TAVRIA STATE AGROTECHNOLOGICAL

*Ternopil* (83 %) and *Zhytomyr* (75 %) regions are the **leaders** in the coverage of HEIs. The situation with the coverage of HEIs by region has improved, as only HEI (without branches/affiliates) located in the region are taken into account.

The **leading regions** in terms of the number of CBHE projects are KHARKIV (35) and LVIV (30) regions and KYIV city (35).

The **leading HEIs** in terms of the number of CBHE projects are Universities that are top-ranking and well experienced in the implementation of international projects – V.N. KARAZIN KHARKIV NATIONAL UNIVERSITY (11), IVAN FRANKO NATIONAL UNIVERSITY OF L'VIV (10), LVIV POLITECHNIC NATIONAL UNIVERSITY (10), SIMON KUZNETS KHARKIV NATIONAL UNIVERSITY OF ECONOMICS (6), KHARKIV NATIONAL UNIVERSITY OF RADIOELECTRONICS (6), KYIV TARAS SHEVCHENKO NATIONAL UNIVERSITY (4 & *1 Coordinator*) located in large cities of Ukraine, as well as HEIs with more limited previous experience – CHERNIHIV POLYTECHNIC NATIONAL UNIVERSITY (9), NATIONAL UNIVERSITY OF WATER AND ENVIRONMENTAL ENGINEERING (Rivne) (6), SUMY NATIONAL AGRARIAN UNIVERSITY (6), TERNOPIL VOLODYMYR HNATIUK NATIONAL PEDAGOGICAL UNIVERSITY (5 & *1 Coordinator*), KHMELNYTSKIY NATIONAL UNIVERSITY (5), ZAPORIZHZHYA NATIONAL UNIVERSITY (5), IZMAIL STATE UNIVERSITY OF HUMANITIES (Odessa region) (5), BOGDAN KHMELNITSKY MELITOPOL STATE PEDAGOGICAL UNIVERSITY (displaced to Zaporizhzhya) (5), as well as DNIPRO UNIVERSITY OF TECHNOLOGY (5) and UKRAINIAN STATE UNIVERSITY OF SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGIES (5 & *1 Coordinator*), which were formed by merging several HEIs.

The positive impact of the results of the merger of HEIs, which took place in 2023-2024, on the advancement to leadership positions due to the strengthening of the human resources and infrastructure potential of DNIPRO UNIVERSITY OF TECHNOLOGY, UKRAINIAN STATE UNIVERSITY OF SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGIES and V.N. KARAZIN KHARKIV NATIONAL UNIVERSITY is obvious.



Представлений аналіз даних щодо кількості проєктів СВНЕ Програми Еразмус+, що реалізуються українськими закладами вищої освіти протягом 2021-2025 рр., дає підстави для таких висновків.

До реалізації 69 проєктів залучені 121 (із 314) ЗВО з 24 (із 26) областей України та м. Києва. Отже, 39 % від загальної кількості українських ЗВО брали участь в проєктах СВНЕ у 2021-2025 рр. (на 7 % зростання у 2025 р.)

Серед цих закладів є 17 ЗВО з Донецької (7), Луганської (2), Запорізької (6) та Херсонської (2) областей – з окупованих територій / прифронтових зон бойових дій, що були переміщені в інші, більш безпечні регіони або міста. Загалом, в Україні 93 повністю зруйнованих та/або пошкоджених ЗВО (36 %) та 19 переміщених (6 %).

У 2025 р. до когорти університетів – учасників проєктів СВНЕ долучилися **20 новачків** (уперше беруть участь у проєктах СВНЕ у період 2021-2025 рр.: 2 дослідницькі інститути та 18 ЗВО, *вкл.* 3 переміщених та 1 як координатор проєкту) з різних регіонів України (Kuras Institute of Politics and Ethnic Studies (1) and

Institute for Single Crystals (1) of the National Academy of Sciences of Ukraine; VASYL STEFANYK CARPATHIAN NATIONAL UNIVERSITY (2), NATIONAL UNIVERSITY "ODESSA MARITIME ACADEMY" (2), BORYS GRINCHENKO KYIV METROPOLITAN UNIVERSITY (1), KROK UNIVERSITY (1), LVIV UNIVERSITY OF TRADE AND ECONOMICS (1), DNIPRO STATE AGRARIAN AND ECONOMIC UNIVERSITY (1), ODESA I.I. MECHNIKOV NATIONAL UNIVERSITY (1), ZAPORIZHZHYA INSTITUTE OF ECONOMICS AND INFORMATION TECHNOLOGIES (1), PENITENTIARY ACADEMY OF UKRAINE (1), KAMIANETS-PODILSKYI IVAN OHIIENKO NATIONAL UNIVERSITY (1), VINNYTSIA NATIONAL AGRARIAN UNIVERSITY (1), NATIONAL UNIVERSITY OF OSTROH ACADEMY (1) HRYHORII SKOVORODA UNIVERSITY IN PEREIASLAV (1), STATE TAX UNIVERSITY (1), PRYAZOVSKYI STATE TECHNICAL UNIVERSITY (*Mariupol, relocated to Dnipro*) (1), DMYTRO MOTORNYI TAVRIA STATE AGROTECHNOLOGICAL UNIVERSITY (*Melitopol, relocated to Zaporizhzhya*) (1), KHERSON STATE MARITIME ACADEMY (*relocated to Odessa*) (1), NIZHYN MYKOLA GOGOL STATE UNIVERSITY (2 as a partner and 1 as a *Coordinator*).

**Лідерами** за охопленням закладів є Тернопільська (83 %) та Житомирська (75 %) області. Ситуація з охопленням ЗВО по регіонах покращилася, адже тепер ураховуються тільки ЗВО (без філій), розташовані в регіоні.

**Регіони-лідери** за кількістю проєктів є Київ (35), Харківська (35) і Львівська (30) області.

**Закладами-лідерами** за кількістю проєктів є як повідні та досвідчені в реалізації міжнародних проєктів ЗВО – V.N. KARAZIN KHARKIV NATIONAL UNIVERSITY (11), IVAN FRANKO NATIONAL UNIVERSITY OF L'VIV (10), LVIV POLYTECHNIC NATIONAL UNIVERSITY (10), SIMON KUZNETS KHARKIV NATIONAL UNIVERSITY OF ECONOMICS (6), KHARKIV NATIONAL UNIVERSITY OF RADIOELECTRONICS (6), KYIV TARAS SHEVCHENKO NATIONAL UNIVERSITY (4 & 1 *Coordinator*), що розташовані у великих містах України, так і ЗВО з меншим попереднім досвідом – CHERNIHIV POLYTECHNIC NATIONAL UNIVERSITY (9), NATIONAL UNIVERSITY OF WATER AND ENVIRONMENTAL ENGINEERING (Rivne) (6), SUMY NATIONAL AGRARIAN UNIVERSITY (6), TERNOPIL VOLODYMYR HNATIUK NATIONAL PEDAGOGICAL UNIVERSITY (5 & 1 *Coordinator*), KHMELNYTSKIY NATIONAL UNIVERSITY (5), ZAPORIZHZHYA NATIONAL UNIVERSITY (5), IZMAIL STATE UNIVERSITY OF HUMANITIES (Odessa region) (5), BOGDAN KHMELNITSKY MELITOPOL STATE PEDAGOGICAL UNIVERSITY (displaced to Zaporizhzhya) (5), а також DNIPRO UNIVERSITY OF TECHNOLOGY (5) та UKRAINIAN STATE UNIVERSITY OF SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGIES (5 & 1 *Coordinator*), що утворені на основі об'єднання кількох закладів.

Очевидним є позитивний вплив результатів об'єднання ЗВО, що відбувалися у 2023-2024 рр., на просування на лідерські позиції завдяки посиленню кадрового та інфраструктурного потенціалу і міжнародної співпраці DNIPRO UNIVERSITY OF TECHNOLOGY, UKRAINIAN STATE UNIVERSITY OF SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGIES та V.N.KARAZIN KHARKIV NATIONAL UNIVERSITY.

Варто зазначити, що участь закладів вищої освіти в проєктах співпраці Еразмус+, зокрема в проєктах CBHE, має вплив на державну атестацію наукової діяльності ЗВО та формулу державного фінансування ЗВО, тому цікавість ЗВО до участі в конкурсах Еразмус+ з кожним роком зростає та є важливою для розбудови потенціалу закладів для їх ефективної участі в наступному етапі Програми ЄС Еразмус+ 2028-2034 рр. у новому асоційованому статусі України та виконання підготовчої роботи для вступу до ЄС.
