Europe is entering a period of rapid shifts shaped by digital technologies, climate pressures, demographic change, and rising geopolitical uncertainties. These developments highlight the central importance of **strong, modern VET systems** that can supply the **technical, operational, and human-centred skills needed across sectors**.

Labour shortages remain persistent in construction, energy, industry, care, and other technical fields. At the same time, the demand for adaptive learning pathways, flexible qualifications, and skilled professionals is growing. VET is increasingly recognised as essential to Europe's capacity to build, maintain, and upgrade its housing, energy, transport, industrial and public-interest systems.

DG EMPL is currently preparing a **new European VET Strategy**, expected to be published before the summer. As part of this process, **VET4EU2 has been asked to provide practical examples from the field**, highlighting real needs, successful approaches, and areas where further support would make a difference.

This workshop, organised by the VET4EU2 group, will bring together partners to refine the thematic priorities, enhance coherence across work strands, and jointly shape a structured approach to the next phase of collaboration.
