



Concept note AI4Students

The AI4Students project tackles two central themes: *Artificial Intelligence (AI)* and *Networking*.

Its mission is to strengthen the Erasmus+ Student and Alumni Alliance's (ESAA) four member organizations by delivering AI training, empowering students within the ESAA network with essential AI skills, and promoting ethical AI usage. The project aims to equip participants with practical tools and a clear understanding of how to leverage AI for their personal development and for the benefit of their organizations.

The project will follow a hybrid format, consisting of three main phases:

- An online introductory session (approx date mid-June)
- An intensive in-person training in Uzhhorod, Western Ukraine. (approx date beginning of July)
- A post-training follow-up session (approx date mid-July)

12 selected students from the network will participate in a professionally designed training and networking program. The course will begin with a theoretical overview of AI, with a strong emphasis on ethics and best practices. Participants will then engage in hands-on activities exploring practical AI applications.

The training will also feature visual learning materials and an international video screening, providing a broader perspective on AI's global impact. In addition, participants will collaborate in groups to brainstorm innovative ways to integrate AI into the Erasmus+ program.

The project is absolutely free of charge, moreover, the organizers will cover the selected participants accommodation, meals and transportation costs.

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
