The policy dialogue conference aims to strengthen the practical implementation of inclusivity and diversity principles within Erasmus+ Actions drawing on insights and expectations from multiple National Agencies of programme countries. It seeks to clarify common standards for fair, accessible, and inclusive opportunities for Institutions in Georgia and the wider Eastern Partnership region, including Armenia, Azerbaijan, Moldova, and Ukraine.

The discussion will also address recurring gaps and narrow interpretations of inclusivity observed in implementation practice, and support greater consistency between institutional procedures and requirements, with the broader goal of improving quality, transparency, and equity within the programme.
